

Philanthropy and Territory Area

Requirements for conference organisation proposals

The Compagnia di San Paolo does not fund conferences, with the limited exception of staff events or events closely related to projects or initiatives supported by the Compagnia. Even in this case the selection criteria are strict and the proponents must demonstrate the relevance of the conference to the projects, of which the event (seminar, conference, etc.) should represent an important and useful moment with specific objectives.

Philanthropy and Territory Area adheres to this general policy. Those who intend to propose initiatives that are consistent with the guidelines of the Compagnia, Philanthropy and Territory Area, can do so bearing in mind the following conditions:

- Unless events are organised or co-organised by the Compagnia Philanthropy and Territory Area itself, the maximum contribution is € 5,000 for a single event;
- The initiative must take place within the Compagnia's fields of operation, being Piedmont, Valle d'Aosta and the Genoa Metropolitan Area;
- Proof must be provided of the value of high dissemination, or the goal of knowledge advancement sought through the event;
- Proof must be provided of the preparation and publication (including digital only) of the event proceedings or at least a report of the event and its results;
- The application should clearly specify which organisational expenses the applicant intends to cover with the proposed contribution from the Compagnia.
- With regard to Communication, the general rules of the Compagnia will be respected.
