

Daniela Del Boca, Ph.D. University of Wisconsin-Madison, is Professor of Economics at the University of Turin and Fellow of Collegio Carlo Alberto. She is also Research Associate of the Institute of Human Development and Social Change (IHDSC) at New York University and of the Becker Friedman Institute on Human Capital and Early Childhood Intervention of the University of Chicago and Research Fellow at IZA(Bonn).

Her main fields of research are Labour Economics, Economics of the family and Applied Econometrics.

Among her publications there are several books and articles in the area of the Economics of the Family and Early Childhood Intervention. Her articles have appeared in international journals, including *The American Economic Review*, *Journal of Human Resources*, *Journal of Population Economics*, *Labour Economics*, the *Review of Income and Wealth*, *European Economic Review* and *Oxford Economic Papers*. Among her recent books: “*Women in the Labor Force: An Economic Perspective*” Oxford University Press (2005) and “*Social Policies, Labour Markets and Motherhood*” Cambridge University Press (2008), *Famiglie Sole Il Mulino* (2009) and *Valorizzare le Donne Conviene Il Mulino* (2012)

Recent work regards the impact of investments in early childhood on children’s cognitive outcomes such as ‘Household Choices and Child Development’, *Review of Economic Studies*, ‘Exploring the role of Child Care in Italy’, *Review of The Economics of the Household* and “Transfers to families with Children and child outcomes” forthcoming in *Economic Journal*.

In 2007 she was awarded the Order of the Merit (Commander of the Italian Republic) "for her contribution to the study of family policies" by the President Giorgio Napolitano. She has been on the Advisory Board of TFIEY (Transatlantic Forum for Inclusive Early Years) since 2013 and since 2014 she has been a member of the Scientific Committee of Confindustria (Italian Industrial Federation) and of the Centro Studi Luca d’Agliano.
